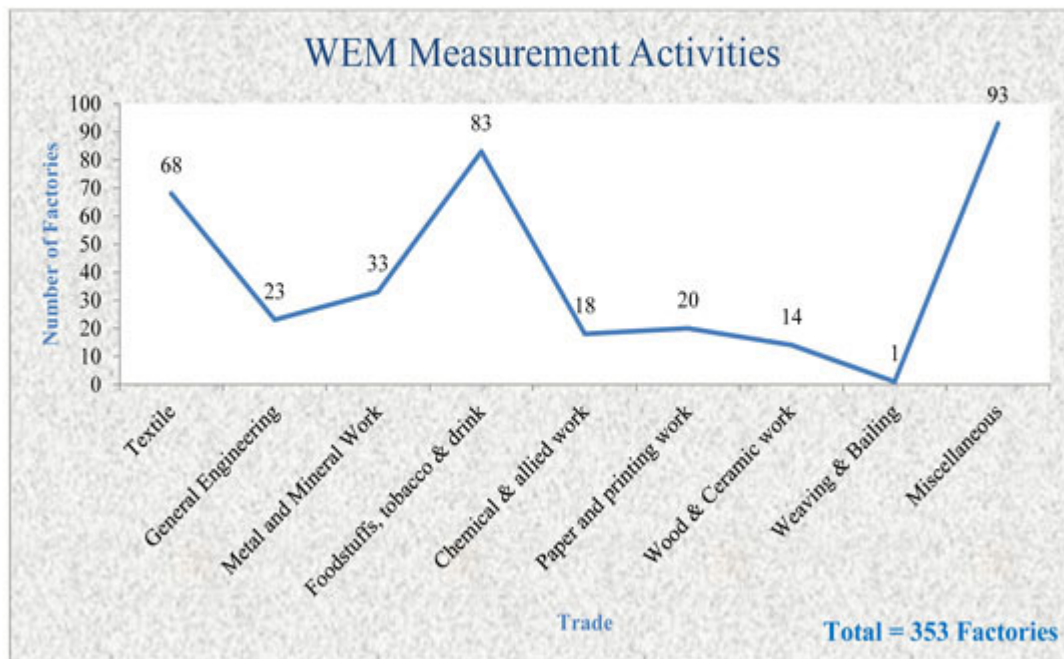
According to the 1951 Factories Act, every manager of factory obligates to inform any accident whatever happens in their workplaces.

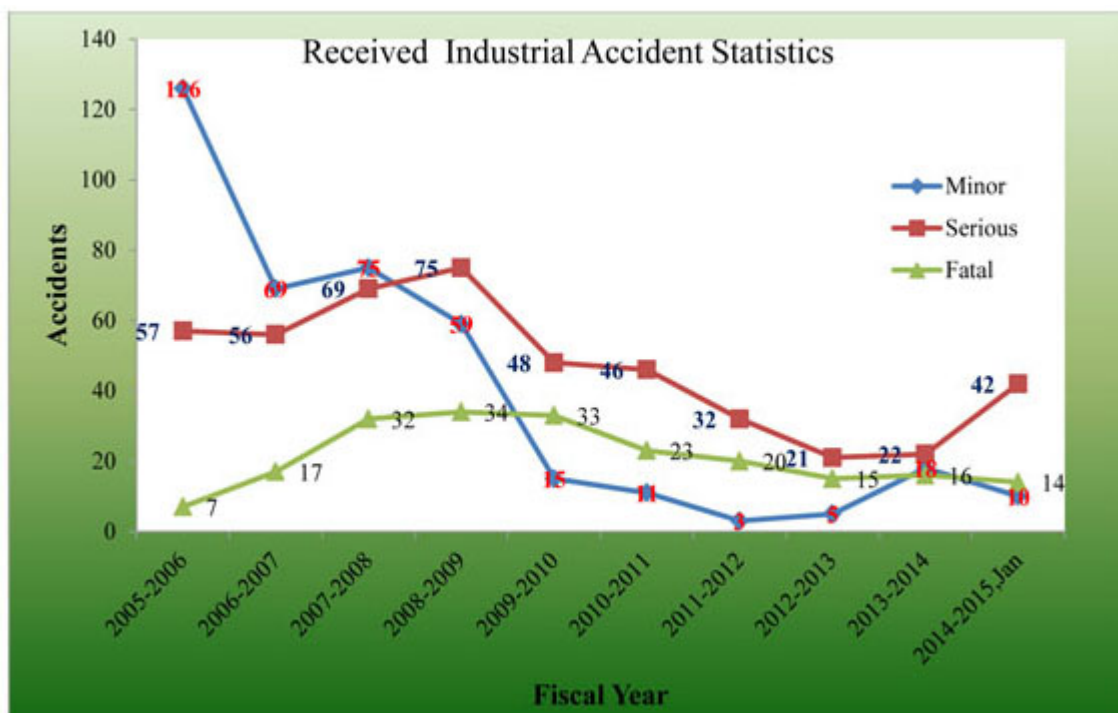
