Intention of the law/ Regulation (OSHS the main law)

safeguard the worker's social and economic well-being as well as his physical safety and health

Framework and Enforcement:

- Policy formulation and monitoring of program implementation on OSH standards and employees' compensation lies with the BWC and the ECC, SSS, and the GSIS respectively.
- Enforcement lies with the DOLE ROs.
- OSHC -focal point for OSH training, research, information, and technical services.

Main Points/ Full text:

- 28 main rules
- Includes rules on premises of establishment, occupational health and environment control, hazardous materials, hazardous work processes, machine guarding, electrical safety, machine guarding, occupational health services, etc.
