



3. Mechanisms for mutual recognition of skills

- Implement an effective and transparent recognition process of competency certification systems (e.g. agreeing on a benchmark for evaluating ANCs; competency certification systems, describing the structure of existing systems against the benchmark, outlining the legal basis and responsibilities of relevant competent bodies, etc.)
- Explore different mechanisms, including mutual recognition arrangements (MRAs) and mutual recognition of skills (MRSs), and different pathways (e.g. partial arrangements with compensatory mechanisms) depending on country context and circumstances; systematically monitor and document the experiences and progresses of various mutual recognition arrangements.
- Implement a gradual approach for strengthening NCPs and for referencing to the AQRF (if not yet done) and establish a multi-stakeholder committee to oversee the processes, with clear responsibilities, targets and milestones.
